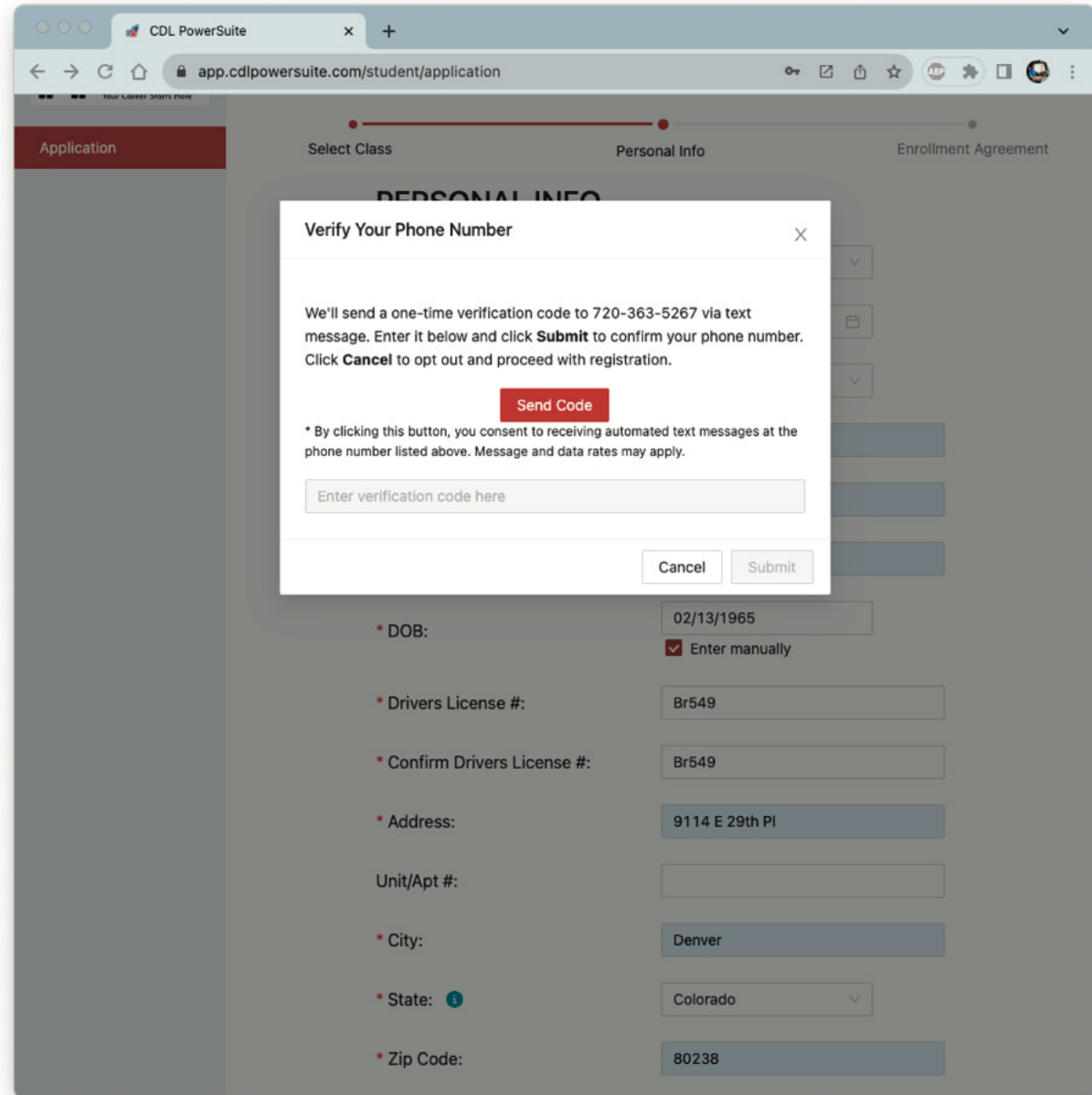

CDL 303, LLC does not discriminate based on race, sex, religion, ethnic origin, or disability.

Prospective students must have a high school diploma or equivalency diploma to be accepted for enrollment. If applicants are beyond the age of compulsory school attendance in Colorado and do not possess a diploma or equivalency diploma, they may complete an ability to benefit test. The school does not administer the test, but will provide information on availability when requested.

- You must hold a valid regular driver license and be at least 18 years old.
- Show current DOT medical card and DOT negative drug screen.
- Proof of current physical Colorado address documents.
- Proof of your Social Security number.

CDL 303, (per DOT regulations) requires all students to complete both a DOT physical and drug screen successfully. Students are allowed to obtain these requirements on their own; however, students are encouraged to ensure that the physical and drug screen that they complete is DOT approved and that a medical examiner's certificate is issued after completing the material. Any student that completes this prerequisite on their own will be required to provide CDL 303 with both the original physical long-form and a copy of their medical examiner's certificate (medical card). 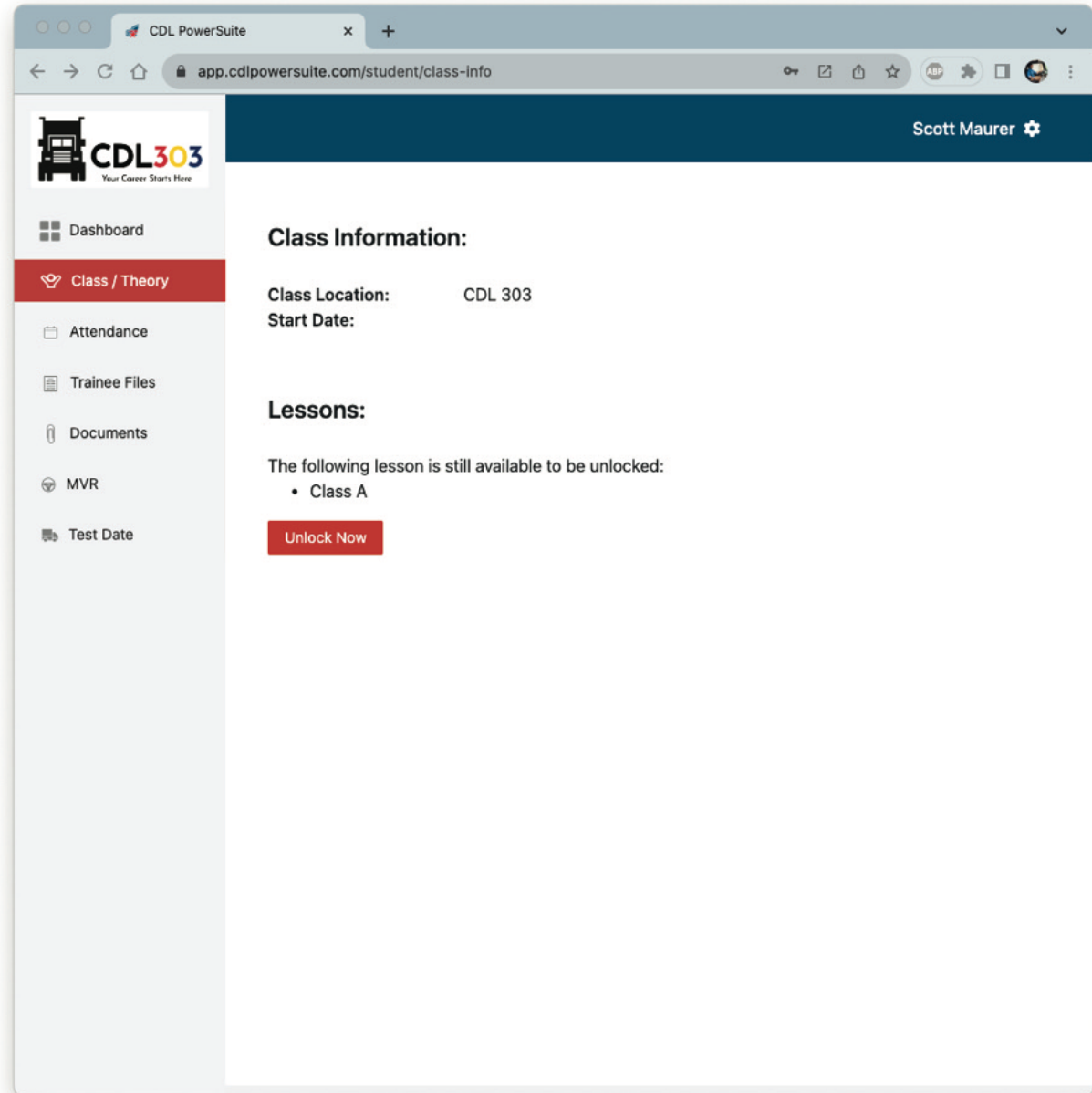
